We have included approximate age guides for each size, use these to help you

Examples:

A very typical 11/12 year old would be in a 32" blazer. If your child is much taller than average then you may need a 34" to allow for sleeve length, but if they are slight then it maybe better to opt for a 31" depending on how much growing room you'd like to allow for

If you would usually purchase a 9/10 for your child then you would choose from the 28", 29" or 30" depending on if they are tall, average for 9/10 or very slight and how much growing room you'd like to allow for.



When a child tries on a blazer for the first time and its their first one then it will feel strange to them.

Most people opt for a blazer that falls between the wrist and the knuckles when arms are laid straight down flat to the body, this will allow for adequate growing room.

Blazers are bought by chest size, so you will need your child's chest measurement to start. To take your child's chest measurement, measure around the fullest part of their chest. For younger children, place the tape measure a few inches below their armpit and measure their chest there. For older children, particularly girls, the fullest part of their chest might be a little lower. Your child will be able to tell you what feels comfortable to them. Be sure not to pull the tape measure too tight

Height and arm length are important considerations when selecting a blazer size so use the chart to consider this alongside the chest measurement.

Consider if your child will be wearing a jumper underneath the blazer.

Try the whole uniform on together before you decide if you've purchased the correct size, it can really change the look.
