Uniform Requirements

Our uniform requirements remain gender-neutral.

Branded items

- College tie;
- College v-neck jumper;
- College black polo shirt (summer term only);
- College blazer.



Non-branded items

- Plain black footwear;
- Plain black smart trousers, knee length skirt, tailored shorts;
- Plain white shirt or blouse.
